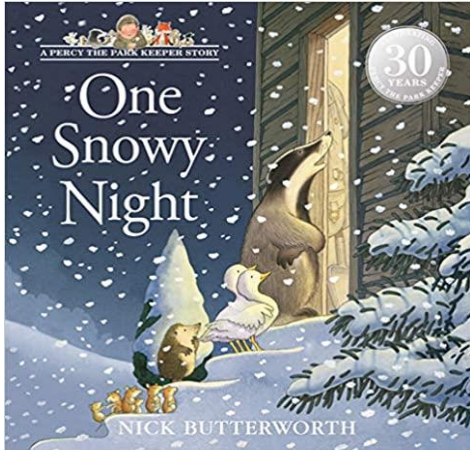

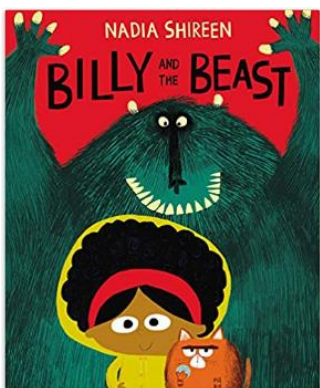
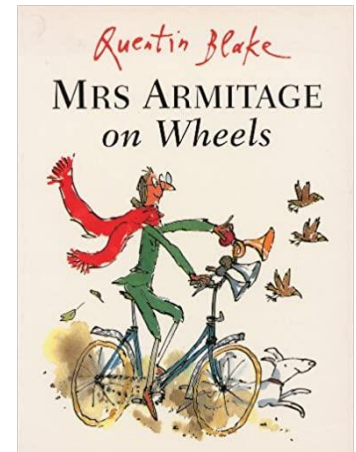
One Snowy Night – Nick Butterworth
