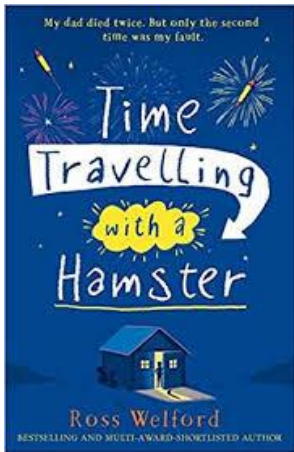

Time Travelling with a Hamster

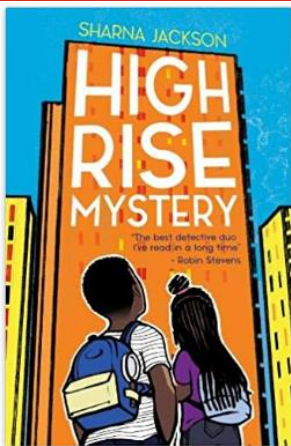
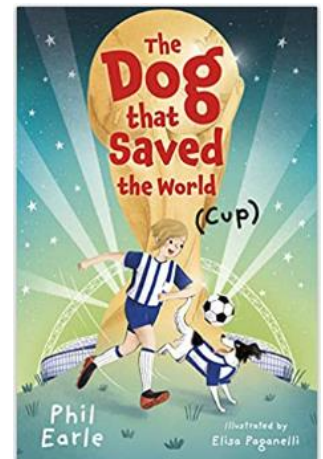
Al Chaudhury is a little boy on a mission and he's taking his hamster with him.
