

Wycombe Abbey School has a valued partner relationship with your child's school. We send our Year 12 and Year 13 pupils to undertake volunteering for one hour a week as part of their Sixth Form curriculum programme. This has been running for several years and is a really important part of their A level provision. Our pupils get a significant amount out of this scheme – indeed for many is the absolute highlight of their week - and it has helped further to integrate Wycombe Abbey into the local Wycombe community.

For the last two years we have run a successful and popular Year 5 primary enrichment programme on a selection of Sunday mornings, run by our Sixth Form pupils and Wycombe Abbey teachers. We begin this in Spring Term of a given academic year, and we will also run sessions in Summer Term; then, when your child goes into Year 6 in the Autumn Term of the next academic year, we also offer Sunday sessions.

Our current Year 12s are really excited to deliver this programme. We will be offering Classics [Introduction to Latin and Greek], Maths, Social Sciences, Music and Languages [Introduction to German]. If you are interested in signing up for this programme, we will run three sessions this term: **Sunday 8th February, Sunday 1st March and Sunday 8th March**. For each morning, it will be a 9am-1pm time window. You do not necessarily have to sign up to all three sessions, but it would be wonderful if you were able to sign up for the block of three.
