Important Changes to Our School Uniform from September 2026

I am writing to inform you about changes to our school uniform policy following new government legislation that comes into force in September 2026.

What's Changing and Why

From September 2026, schools must limit the number of compulsory branded items of uniform and PE kit to 3 or fewer. This change has been introduced by the government to help reduce uniform costs for families.

Our New Uniform Requirements

From September 2026, these items will become optional:

- School branded red PE T-shirt (any plain red t-shirt can be worn instead)
- School branded book bag
- School branded PE drawstring bag

Our three compulsory branded items will be:

- Blazer
- Jumper or cardigan
- Sweatshirt

All other uniform items can be purchased from any retailer, if they meet the colour and style requirements.

Where to Buy Uniform

- **Branded items:** Available from [Sports Crest](#)
- **Non-branded items:** Can be purchased from any retailer
- **Second-hand uniform:** Can be purchased through the school office

When Do These Changes Take Effect?

The new requirements come into force in **September 2026**. Children can continue to wear existing uniform - you do not need to purchase new items immediately.
