Re: Important Information – Extreme Heat Arrangements for Wednesday and Thursday

Following guidance from Buckinghamshire Public Health and the Met Office's Red weather warning for extreme heat, we are making some temporary changes to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children and staff on Wednesday and Thursday.

Temperatures are expected to reach exceptionally high levels, so we will be taking the following measures:

- **Children will remain indoors between 11.00am and 3.00pm** when the sun is at its strongest.
- **Cross Country and other outdoor activities** during these times have been cancelled.
- **Healthy Heroes Week** will continue, with activities adapted where necessary and moved indoors wherever possible to ensure children remain safe and comfortable in the extreme heat.
- **Water stations** will be available and children will have regular hydration breaks throughout the day. We will actively encourage all children to drink plenty of water.
- **Classroom blinds** will be closed where appropriate and rooms ventilated to help keep temperatures as comfortable as possible.
- Staff will closely monitor children who may be more vulnerable to the effects of the heat.

To help us keep everyone safe, please ensure that your child:

- Brings a named **water bottle** to school each day.
- Applies **sun cream** before coming to school
- Brings a **sunhat**.
- Continues to come to school in **PE kit**, which is cooler and more comfortable in the hot weather.

Due to the exceptional weather circumstances, children may bring small hand-held fans to school this week. However, there will be rules in place about their use and they remain the responsibility of the children at all times.



We will continue to monitor the situation closely and will keep you informed should any further changes be necessary. The health and wellbeing of our children and staff remains our highest priority.
