Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Sports Day – Monday 29 June 2026

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our Sports Day on Monday and are pleased that the weather forecast is much cooler than the temperatures we experienced earlier this week.

To ensure that the children remain comfortable throughout the event, we will have gazebos in place to provide shade and plenty of drinking water available throughout the day.

Please ensure that your child is sent to school with the following items:

- Sunhat
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen applied before coming to school in the morning

As Sports Day takes place on Wycombe Abbey's athletics field, there is very little natural shade available for spectators. If you are planning to attend, we recommend bringing anything you may need to stay comfortable, such as a hat, sunscreen or a small umbrella/parasol for shade if you wish.

Access to the School Site

Wycombe Abbey is currently carrying out construction work at the front of the school, which has resulted in temporary changes to the usual access arrangements. Please read the information below carefully to help ensure everyone arrives safely.

If you are arriving on foot:

Please enter via the **War Office Gate**, which is accessed from **Wendover Way (The Rye)**. This entrance is located next to the athletics track and provides the safest and most direct pedestrian access to the Sports Day field.

If you are arriving by car:

Please use the **Crispin Way Gate**, accessed from **Daws Hill Lane**. Parking will be available along **Lime Avenue** and in the **staff car park next to the athletics track**. Please follow any directions from Wycombe Abbey staff and High Wycombe C of E School staff on arrival.



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We would be grateful if you could allow a little extra time for your journey due to these temporary changes.

Please ensure that you arrive in good time, as races will begin promptly at the times shown below:

- **KS2 Races:** 9:30am – 11:30am
- **Reception and KS1:** 1:00pm – 3:00pm

We are looking forward to an exciting day of competition, teamwork and encouragement, and we hope to see many of you there supporting the children.
