Dear Parents/Carers,

Forest School

On **Wednesday 16th September**, Year 6 will begin their Forest School sessions for the Autumn Term. These will take place in the woods at the foot of Tom Burt's Hill, a short walk from school.

Year 6 will take part in Forest School **every Wednesday afternoon for five weeks**, up until the Autumn Half Term break.

On Forest School days, children should **come to school wearing suitable outdoor clothing**, which they will wear throughout the day. Please choose comfortable, practical clothes that you do not mind getting dirty.

Forest School will take place **whatever the weather**, including when it is raining. Children should therefore bring appropriate additional clothing for the conditions, such as:

waterproof coat and trousers

wellington boots or other suitable waterproof footwear

additional warm layers if needed

sunhat and sun protection during warmer weather

Children may also bring **a change of clothes** in case they get particularly wet or muddy during the afternoon.

Chiltern Rangers Visit

On **Monday 7th September**, Chiltern Rangers will be coming into school to help us prepare the meadow area and butterfly garden for the year.

Year 6 will be working alongside the Chiltern Rangers **throughout the day**, helping with activities such as digging, weeding and planting.

Children should therefore come to school wearing **practical outdoor clothing and suitable footwear that can get dirty**.

This activity will also take place in poor weather, so please ensure that children bring **waterproof clothing and a change of clothes if rain is forecast**.
