**Costumes**

Please ensure that your child brings his/her costume to school on Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> March.

**Dress Rehearsal**

We shall walk to the Swan Theatre in costume at 9.30am for a 10.00am start on 20<sup>th</sup> March. We plan to return to school between 12.30-12.45 but we need to be flexible so please provide your child with a packed lunch.

**The performance**

Children should be dropped off at the Oak Room entrance to the Town Hall by **6:45pm** on both evenings. Please note that cars are not allowed in the turning circle to drop off children.

The process of dismissing so many children has to be tightly managed so we would ask you to be patient if you are kept waiting.


