

## **PGL Overview for Parents**

### **What does the PGL trip involve?**

We will be taking the Year 6 class on a PGL outdoor adventure residential to the Osmington Bay centre near Weymouth, Dorset. It is a real adventure, which begins with the two-and-a-half-hour journey there and continues throughout the week until the return on the Friday.

We have used this Centre for many years. The accommodation was used by some of the athletes (water sports) in the 2012 Olympics, and so is therefore of a high standard.

The Osmington Bay Centre offers a full week of activities with continuous adult supervision throughout the day and evening, from the largest and most respected provider of outdoor and adventurous activity breaks in the UK. The safety and security of all those attending is paramount and PGL have detailed information detailing the safety measures they adhere to as well as being endorsed by affiliation to the principal sporting and travel associations.
