Pupil Premium Reporting to Parents

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2011/12 was: £8,170

The PPG allocation for 2011/2012 was targeted to:

- a) Appointed a Literacy Manager to monitor and evaluate the teaching of Early Reading and Phonics
- b) Create smaller teaching groups for the teaching of Reading at KS1
- c) Fund an intensive programme for the teaching of Phonics
- d) Buy a scheme for the teaching of Phonics

The impact of the PPG for 2011/12 was:

- a) The areas for development in the teaching of reading were highlighted and the Literacy Manager provided support in 'closing the gap' between reading and writing
- b) Teaching of reading provision strengthened across the school and a smoother transition between Years 2 and 3
- c) 100% of the teaching and support staff are now fully trained in the teaching of Phonics
- d) Percentage of children passing the Year One Phonics screening check is significantly above national average
