The Christmas Production 2025- Superstar! - Costumes

Year 1:

Year 2:

Please can Year 2 dress as innkeepers- tunics over baggy trousers; rough linen aprons with money pockets, or money belts.

Year 3:

Year 3 will perform 'We're Not Washing our Socks'

Traditional shepherd's costumes would be great - a tea towel for headdress, baggy t-shirt and trousers. Checked patterns and earthy colours.

Year 4:

Year 4 will perform 'Alleluia'

Year 4 will be traditional angels for their song. White dresses, leggings and t shirts with wings and a tinsel halo.

Year 5:

Year 5 will perform 'Wise Men from Lands Afar'.

Traditional King's costumes would be fantastic- crowns and cloaks would be perfect accessories! Bright colours and jewels would make the Kings stand out.

Year 6:

Year 6 will perform 'Superstar' and 'Light of The World'

The children need to be dressed in black for both songs.

If your child has an acting part in the play (Year 6 and some Year 5s only), an additional letter will be sent detailing what each character will need to wear.
